Hi Michelle,

After a whirlwind couple of weeks on the topic of DPWD's CVP Construction Obligation, I thought it only fair to let you and Michael know where my Board landed after a Special Board Meeting called for today due to updates since our Wednesday meeting. Sometime next week, we will be wiring our Exhibit C Lump Sum payment in the amount of \$14,124,614.

The sources of funds that we will be utilizing to accomplish this will be \$2,276,461 out of DPWD's reserve funds, and a borrowed amount of \$11,848,153. The borrowed amount is what we are assessing our customers for, and that is the amount of the District's undiscounted Construction Obligation as calculated in the Draft 2021 rate books after the implementation of the CVP CAS. The decision to do this will put quite a strain on the District's cash flow, but it also helped avoid the situation where we would cause our customers to pay interest on borrowed money that they didn't truly owe.

The District will be keenly interested in the process for the application of credit offsets against any overpayments of Construction Obligation, per the Repayment Contract, as we will need to utilize those credits for our obligations going forward and it will likely take a couple of years or more for us to realize them.

We will also hold high hopes for the FY 2020 Annual Accounting process to commence and conclude at the fastest pace possible, as we are expecting to have a + \$2 million refund of the Construction Repayment made through our estimated rates for FY 2020 water deliveries. That refund will in the short term help us with cash flows, and in the long run be returned to our customers.

I am still disappointed that we were not able to prevail in our argument to pay the post-CVP CAS implementation balance due, but I know that you both took the request seriously and did try to find a solution with the RD and the Solicitors. For that, I truly thank you!

If we do not speak before next week, please accept my sincere wishes for your Thanksgiving Holiday to be blessed with good food and a safe environment, and the comfort of knowing that at this time next year we will all probably be planning a huge family gathering!

Hello Anthea,

Per our Solicitor's Office the DPWD repayment contract with BOR is current and in effect. As such, any payments you send after the effective date of the repayment contract will be processed pursuant to the contract and are subject to the provisions of the WIIN Act. We were also advised that the Exhibit C that accompanied the contract you signed is final and cannot be updated. To my knowledge, BOR has updated exhibits leading up until the point of contract signing but not after. While there is provision in the contract to make adjustments for payments not reflected in the schedule as you pointed out, adjustments will be made for payments made prior to contract conversion and only after the payments become final through our 2020 accounting analysis process. Unfortunately, the correspondence below pertaining to Exhibit C would only be applicable to contracts approaching WIIN conversion. The scenario would not apply for DPWD because your contract has already been executed.

Please know that we exhausted all legal options to process your request; however, we were advised that the WIIN Act language directs us with the language "shall" and there is no discretion. Therefore, once the contract conversion is final under WIIN the contract trumps all local rate setting policies. We are committed to and have been instructed by the Regional Director to process any eligible refunds and credits at the earliest opportunity. We anticipate you will see activity for DPWD as early as March 2021.

I will follow up with a phone call to you directly after sending this message.
